HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

As Hurricane Season in South Louisiana approaches each year, it is important that we have a clear understanding of each of our Fresh Market by Premier locations' preparedness expectations and plans. Below are three options our company typically facilitates in the event of an approaching storm. Please review each option carefully. In the case of impending landfall, your customer service representative will reach out to discuss which of these options will fit your location best.

- **Option 1:** Your location will be visited and audited pre-storm. If your market has **backup power & internet** it will continue to operate as usual unless it is not safe for our team to travel to stock it. If your market does not have backup power & internet, you can choose to **purchase all of the items in the market** for use during the disruption, or you may opt for us to empty & **close your market**. Either way, the market will be resupplied with food & other items once it is determined that it is safe for our team to get to your facility & bring it back online.
- **Option 2:** We will provide a limited selection of **'prepaid' meals** for all staff to utilize pre/post-storm. For this to work effectively, our clients would provide us with a **head count of expected on-site personnel**. We would provide three market-style meals per employee for each day. This would require backup power for the market or alternative cold storage.
- **Option 3:** As you may be aware, we also operate our **Premier Support Services division**. Through this division we can propose supplying three meals per day per employee post event: **2 hot meals (breakfast and dinner) and 1 boxed lunch drop-off**.
